KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Graham Mabury has been presenter of 6PR's Nightline programme for the past 33 years. Graham pioneered rehabilitation courses for homeless young people in Perth and has received numerous awards for similar humanitarian work. Graham was the inaugural Chairman of the Living Stone Foundation, which became Lifeline WA, in no small part due to the support of the Mt Pleasant Baptist Church, where he has been a pastor for 32 years. Graham began his career in education as a Secondary Teacher becoming Head of



the Music Department at a specialist music school. Graham entered the media at the ABC as an Education Producer, then as a 'leap of faith' he joined a faith based agency working with homeless young people. He has been married to Merle for 43 years and they have twin sons, two beautiful 'new daughters' (their wives) and five wonderful grandchildren.
